Scripture Lesson: Galatians 3:26-4:7 "In fact, you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. ²⁷ Indeed, as many of you as were baptized into Christ have been clothed with Christ. ²⁸ There is not Jew or Greek, slave or free, male or female, for you are all one and the same in Christ Jesus. ²⁹ And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's descendants [a] and heirs according to the promise.

4 What I am saying is this: As long as the heir is a young child, he is no different from a slave. Although he is owner of everything, ² he is still under guardians and managers until the day set by his father. ³ So also, when we were younger children, we were enslaved under the basic principles of the world. ⁴ But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son to be born of a woman, so that he would be born under the law, ⁵ in order to redeem those under the law, so that we would be

adopted as sons. ⁶ And because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts to shout, "*Abba*, Father!" ⁷ So you are no longer a slave, but a son. And if you are a son, then you are also an heir of God through Christ."
