First Scripture Lesson: Galatians 5:1-12 "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not allow anyone to put the yoke of slavery on you again. <sup>2</sup> Look, I, Paul, tell you that if you allow yourselves to be circumcised, Christ will be of no benefit to you. <sup>3</sup> I testify again to every man who allows himself to be circumcised that he is obligated to do the whole law. <sup>4</sup> You who are trying to be declared righteous by the law are completely separated from Christ. You have fallen from grace.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> Indeed, through the Spirit, we by faith are eagerly waiting for the sure hope of righteousness. <sup>6</sup> For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision matters. Rather, it is faith working through love that matters. <sup>7</sup> You were running well! Who cut in on you, so that you are no

longer persuaded by the truth? <sup>8</sup> This persuasion is not from the one who calls you. <sup>9</sup> A little yeast works through the whole batch. <sup>10</sup> I am confident in the Lord that you will have no other opinion than this. But the one who is trying to disturb you will pay the penalty, whoever he is.

<sup>11</sup>Brothers, <sup>[a]</sup> if I am still preaching circumcision, why am I still being persecuted? Then the offense of the cross has been abolished. <sup>12</sup> If only those who are upsetting you would also cut themselves off!"

Gospel: Luke 9:23-26 "When the days were approaching for him to be taken up. Jesus was determined[a] to go to Jerusalem. 52 He sent messengers ahead of him. They went and entered a Samaritan village to make preparations for him. <sup>53</sup> But the people did not welcome him, because he was determined to go to Jerusalem. <sup>54</sup> When his disciples James and John saw this, they said, "Lord, do you want us to call down fire from heaven to consume them?" [b] 55 But he turned and rebuked them. "You don't know what kind of spirit is influencing you. <sup>56</sup> For the Son of Man did not come to destroy people's souls, but to save them."[c] Then they went to another village. <sup>57</sup> As they went on the way, a man said to him, "I will follow you wherever you go." 58 Jesus said to him, "Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head." <sup>59</sup> He said to another man, "Follow me!" But he said, "Lord, first let me go and bury my father." 60 Jesus told him, "Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and proclaim the kingdom of God." 61 Another man also said, "I will follow you, Lord, but first let me say good-bye to those at my home." 62 Jesus told him, "No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God."
