**First Scripture Lesson:** Hebrews 5:7-10 “In the days of his flesh,<sup>[a]</sup> he offered prayers and pleas with loud cries and tears to the one who was able to save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverence. <sup>8</sup> Although he was the Son, he learned obedience from the things he suffered. <sup>9</sup> After he was brought to his goal, he became the source of eternal salvation for everyone who obeys him, <sup>10</sup> because he was designated by God as a high priest, like Melchizedek..”

**Gospel:** John 12:20-33 “Now there were some Greeks among those who went up to worship at the Festival. <sup>21</sup> They came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and asked him, “Sir, we want to see Jesus.” <sup>22</sup> Philip went to tell Andrew. And the one who hates his life in this world will hold on to it for eternal life. <sup>26</sup> If anyone serves me, let him follow me. And where I am, there my servant will be also. If anyone serves me, the Father will honor him.

<sup>27</sup> “Now my soul is troubled. And what shall I say? ‘Father, save me from this hour’? No, this is the reason I came to this hour. <sup>28</sup> Father, glorify your name!” A voice came from heaven: “I have glorified my name, and I will glorify it again.”

<sup>29</sup> The crowd standing there heard it and said it thundered. Others said an angel talked to him. <sup>30</sup> Jesus answered, “This voice was not for my sake but for yours. <sup>31</sup> “Now is the judgment of this world. Now the ruler of this world will be thrown out. <sup>32</sup> And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself.” <sup>33</sup> He said this to indicate what kind of death he was going to die.”
